

Thinking about staff requirements for 2023? MSD has subsidies that could help!

Mana in Mahi: If you have a permanent position, leading into a NZQA recognised training pathway (min 60 credits), then you can get help with the cost of Training, Wages, etc.

- MSD offers employers up-to \$16,000 in wage subsidies for Year 1
- Each agreement includes \$8,000 in Course Fees which can be paid to employers towards course fees
- MSD also offers trainees up-to \$3,000 in incentive payments for Year 1

Mana in Mahi is funding paid to employers to support their commitment towards training and sustainable employment. The employer is responsible for enrolling the employee into a training provider, guiding them through their assessments and course completion.

Flexi-Wage: It's one of the ways Work and Income is supporting employers to get more people into work. It includes:

- . Wage support of \$276 per week is paid to an employer for 24 weeks
- · Free recruitment service
- . Training and education support up to \$5000 can be redeemed towards ACOD Cert IV Optical Dispensing Course
